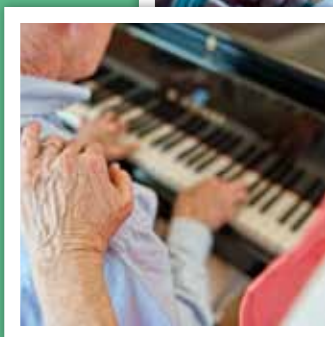
Volunteer Programs

PALMETTO HEALTH RICHLAND
